I Russell Tuckett of the County of Nash and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life do therefore make and give this and declare this to be my last will and testament that is to say First after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged the residue of my estate real and personal I give bequeath and dispose of as follows to wit I leave to J. Powell my daughter my home tract of land with all appurtenances thereto containing two hundred and thirteen acres more or less provided my beloved wife Sally shall have a home on said land and be supported on said land with other provisions herein after named This land shall not be sold or any part thereof embezzled during either of the above parties natural life after the death of the said parties it is my will that said estate be equally divided among Mary G. Powell's bodily heirs.

I leave to my wife Sally Tract of land containing two choice beds and furniture one dozen choice chairs one bureau one clock one walnut dining table & the kitchen furniture It is my will that the tract of land lying on the River known as the Rice lands containing one hundred and seventy three acres be sold out yearly and the interest of the proceeds and all interest on all my notes & accounts and what the balance of my estate shall be sold for the use be held in a trust for the individual support of my wife Sally Tuckett.

After the death of my wife Sally Tuckett it is my will that the last named tract of land be sold and the proceeds be equally divided between the bodily heirs of my dear son & daughter W. H. B. Tuckett & Emily J. Melton it is my will should the bodily heirs of the above named W. H. B. Tuckett and Emily J. Melton die before they are twenty one years of age their said estate to be equally divided between the heirs and those that may survive of said heirs

It is my will at the death of my wife Sally Tuckett that the money notes and the proceeds of sale of personal property after mentioned be equally divided between R. G. Powell bodily heirs, Emily J. Powell should she be living at the death of my wife Sally then the one third to her which is her heirs otherwise I make testamente and appoint J. W. Powell and Mary G. And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trustee friends to execute this my last will and testament James Richardson and Margaret Richardson his wife according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof. hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other wills and testaments by me heretofore made.
