Westray and Kizeah "estray toher and her heirs forever. Item: I give and bequeath to myson and 1. Gurl one bed and furniture to be kept and taken care of by sam Vick untill said Exum arrives to the age of twenty one years or marries also I give him one blue chest to be taken care of in like manner to him and his heirs forever. I also charge said ham 3 Curl the hire of his negro Sam and the interest of his money for raising clothing and schooling said orphan. My will and desire is after all my just debts and legacies be paid, and that the ballance of my estate igany be equally disked amongst my children Mary Westray Sam Vick, and their l. Girl to them and their heirs forever. also all the pattle and sheep that came from my brother came and their increase I leave to him am Westray to do what he place with. Also my will and desire is that all I have should be taken care of and kept tagether by my son am Vick as the I was to live until his finishes his crop all to his use and profit. Also I constitute and appoint my loving son am Vick my hole and sole executor to this my last will and to tament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this 18th dayof March, 1814.
