Item: I give and bequeath unto mysonJames Emelius Pering theballance of my hamblies tract of land, after taking off the fifty six agree above mentioned also one negro man abraham at the death of my wife to him and hisheirs forever.

Item: I give and bequeats unto my son Jesiah Nicholas Dering one negro woman Susan and her increase to him and isheirs forever; and I also live and bequeath to him my said son Josish Michelas Dering all of the perishable property loaned my wife at her death the plantation I now live on as already specified, one negro man Dick, negro women priss, negro weman Rose and negro weman Pinny and their increase tohim and his hei s forever; and farther my wish and desire is that my sen Jno. Randolph Bering shall take the guardian ship of my said sonJosiah Nicholas Dering and last of all I make and appoint mysen John Randolph Dering, Mathanial Harrison and Joshua Watson my executors to this mylast will andtestament mwitness whereof I have hereunto set myhand and seal this 10th dayof December - A D 1846 Jno.
