It is to be observed that the negro woman Hannah I have before given to my daughter Nancy O'Neal with her coming increase I mean and do give to my said daughter during her life time and after her death to the heirs of her body lawfully begotten. Item: I give and bequeath to my beloved son Joel Tisdal one negro boy named Jacob to him and his heirs and assigns forever freely by him to be possess of. Item: I give and bequeath to my beloved son Elisha Tisdal one negro boy named Pomp with also one negro boy given me by my father after the death of my said father boy named Jim I give also to my son Elisha Tisdal each boy to him and his assigns forever. freely by him to be ~~possessed~~ ^{possessed} of.

Item: I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Anzada Tisdal negro woman named Agg to her and her heirs if she shall live to have an heir and if my said daughter should die without heirs then and in that case the said negro Agg is to be sold to the highest bidder in my children and the money arising there from to be equally divided in shares to each of my said children.
