. Item: I give and bequeath to six of my children (that is to say) Cleah Silvah, Bathsheba, Demsey, Betsey, and Hardy, to each the sum of one dollar, They being already provided for.

Item: AIL the rest and residue of p estate of whatevernature of kind I leave to be sold by my executors on a credit and the proceeds after the payment of debts equally divided between my three children Jesse, Allen and Asey Hill Morris.

Item: It is my will and desire also, that after the death of my said wife Preston, that the land and plantation together with all the other articles of property with its increase which is hereby lent only for the term of life, should be sold by my executor also on a credit and the nett amount equally divided between my said three children Jesse, Allen and Asey Hill Morris, to them and their heirs forever.

and lastly. I hereby constitute and appoint my friend John H. Drake and my son Jesse Morris my executor s to this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have, hereunto set and affixed my hand and seal this little day of February 1806.
