Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Ann Chapman a stock horses cattle sheep and hoggs that she all ready haith and

Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Dun a stock of horses cattle sheep andhoggs that she already haith and one negro boy

Items I lend my dearly beloved wife Martha the following negroes, Josiah, and Fann, Rofe, Charlet, Deliaha, Egbert, Simon, Beaser, during the term of seven years after my death, then the above mentioned negroes and their increase to be equally divided between my beloved wife and my following children (to wit) my beloved sons, John Crowell, James Barnes, Crowell, and Edward Crowell, my will is that, that part of thenegroes that falls to my wife after the division, shall at her death return to my estate with their increase and bequally divided between my three sons, John, James Barnes and Edward Crowell to them and their heirs forever.
