Mitchell , Lucy and Allston also one feather bed and furniture one case of bottles viz. The Bottle case and all the bottles therein, and also after the death or marriage of my wife Penelope, the still, still cap and worm, the small walnut folding table and minted chest to thim and hisheirs forever.
