In the name of God Amen I Aaron Alexander living low in bodily health but undiminished memory after I commit my body to the dust and my soul to god who gave it I dispose of my earthly substance as followeth

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife all my stock household and kitchen furniture provision of every kind and farming utensils one gig & harness and other things belonging to the plantation that I may die possessed of. I also leave to my wife the plantation whereon I now live during her natural life also the following negroes Viz Kimbo Edmond Margaret and Sarah Ann, Mary & Nancy.

I give and bequeath to my son Obediah F Alexander the following negroes Viz Betsy Deal Barn Robert Hamah Quaker and George

I give and bequeath to my son Charles H. Alexander the following negroes Viz Trudy Phuby Grace John Clary Dick and Kellister

I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Caroline Alexander at the death of my wife the plantation whereon I now live also at my death the following negroes Viz Tom Fred Sophia Sharlot, Hickey, Tinker, Larry and Estee also one more named Bet It is my will at the death of my wife the negroes left to her shall be equally divided between my three children Obediah F Alexander, Charles H. Alexander and Sarah Caroline Alexander

It is my will that if my daughter Sarah Caroline Alexander should die before she becomes of age or her lawful issue then and in that case the property willed to her shall be equally divided amongst my grand children

I hereby appoint my loving wife Executrix and my Son Obediah F Alexander and Charles H. Alexander Executors to this my last will and testament As witness my hand and seal this sixteenth day of December in the year of our Lord 1843

In the Name of God Amen. I Will and Anderson
of the State of North Carolina & the County of New Hanover,
being very sick & weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory
thank God to god, Calling unto mind the mortality of my body,
and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do
make and ordain this my last will and testament; That is to
say principally and first of all, I give and recommend my
soul unto the hands of Almighty God that made it, and my
body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian
burial at the discretion of my friends, nothing doubting but at
the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God. And as to such my worldly estate
wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give
divide and dispose of the same in the following manner and
form: I give & bequeath unto my Son James Anderson all the
property belonging to me of every kind consisting of one Mare &
all my Cattle, Hogs, Bees with my household property of every
description that is by me possessed. Yet nevertheless I wish my Son
James Anderson just in my name & in the name of humanity
to maintain, take care of and protect my present wife Elizabeth
Anderson so long as she has a mind to remain on his premises
in peace & prudent behavior and not otherwise. All the above named
property & claim, due me in any way or manner I give to my
said Son James Anderson by him freely to be possessed and enjoyed.
And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and
every other former Testament, Will, legacies, bequests and execu-
tors by me in any ways before named written and bequeathed, ratify-
ing and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament.
