Bulloch, a negro woman named Hannah and her two children, Frank and Sue, to her, and her heirs forever, I give, devise and bequeath, unto my dearly beloved wife Eliza M. Bulloch, all the rest and residue of my estate real personal and mixed, for and during her life, and at her death all of said property of every description, together with all its increase I give and bequeath to my son Alexander M. Bulloch to him, his heirs and assigns forever, But it is my will and desire that all my debts be paid by my Executor, hereinafter named out of the said property devised to my beloved wife Eliza and my son Alexander, Lastly, I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my friend Thomas H. Davis Executor, of this my last will and Testament, In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3^d day of October, A.D. 1812, Signed, Sealed, published and declared in the presence of } Alexander M.
