In the name of God Amen. I, Asa Murray,
of the County of New Hanover, and State of North Carolina,
being weak, in body, but of sound and perfect mind and mem-
ory, blessed be Almighty God for the same, do make and publish
this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following:
I give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth, two negroes, big, Sam
and Rachel, one horse, one yoke of oxen, one year's provision, ten
year old hogs, two sows and pigs, three cows and calves, two beds
and furniture, two tables, a sufficient part of kitchen furniture,
also a sufficient quantity of plantation tools, and possession of
all the land if not sold. All of the above named property to
be own used during her natural life, except the land is not
sold for the price of twenty five hundred dollars, and not less
without the consent of my wife and executors and administrators.
I do hereby empower my wife, executors or administrators to sell
all my lands and make titles to the same. I do hereby empower
my wife to draw and take all the property of my children that
is under age, if the land is sold, after receiving her proportionable
part of the money received for the land, and give each of the
children of age their proportionable part of the money received for
the land. If the upper piece of land purchased from Boney Playee
say two hundred and sixty six acres can be sold for more money
than I gave him for it, with interest from the date of the deed, the
balance to be placed to the use of the said Boney Playee.—
I give and bequeath to my four youngest children, viz, Owen, Nancy
and Patsey, to have fifty dollars each extra for schooling, David to

had one hundred dollars for the same extra.

Also give and bequeath to my son Obed Edmund one hundred dollars and a horse, for his meritorious services, over and above his equal share with the rest of the heirs.

I leave the remainder of my property to be equally divided between my children, viz., Obed Edmund, Sarah, Estelle, Alcy, Anna, Nancy, Davis and Patsy.

N.B. If my land should be sold and my family should removal on to Florida or adjoining countries; then the children under age to choose guardians, and for their guardians to lay out the part of the money in buying land or negroes.

I hereby appoint my friends Samuel Black, Ezekiel Lane, and Thomas Pleyer, sole executors of this my last Will and Testament.

A Codicil to my last Will and Testament, (viz.)
The two negroes named out for my wife, viz., Sam and Rachel, is not to be the particular ones, my wife is to have; she is to have her choice of any two negroes that I possess, a male and female, all the property left by me to my daughters, shall be to them and the lawful heirs of their bodies. If any one of them die without issue, their proportionable part of the property to be equally divided among the rest of the children. If either of my sons die without issue, their part of the property shall likewise be equally divided among the rest of the heirs.

In addition to my executors I appoint my son Obed Edmund Murray given under my hand and seal in the presence of us, and in the year of our Lord October 30th 1826,
