Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Unity, all my stock, of horses, cattle and hogs, and household furniture, to her and her heirs forever. Also I give and bequeath to my said wife Unity, all the moneys that I have or that is due or coming to me in the State aforesaid, or also in Island of Jamaica to her, and her heirs forever. Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Unity, during her natural life, one negro man named Providence, and after death to devolve in equal moiety and division between Caleb Loper Nichols, and Mary Jane Lee, to them and their heirs forever,

and I do by these presents nominate and ordain my wife Unity and Thomas Bishop Junior, my Executors to this my last Will and Testament, revoking all other wills and acknowledging this my last Will and Testament and no other. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifteenth day of August in the year of our Lord 1818. Signed, sealed and acknowledged Charles Oaling. Seal in presence of us, Witnesses
