Testament,

I give unto my son Sedgwick Springs, all my goods and chattels and
personal estate, after payment of my funeral expences, giving and
bequeathing unto my said son, all and every thing I am possessed, wh-
-atever, and where so ever, which I also charge with the payment of
my said funeral expences; and I hereby appoint Mr Richard Player,
to be sole executor of this my last Will and Testament, and Trustee for
my said son until of age. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 12th day of April 1771.
