bequeathing unto my said son, all and every thing I am possessed, whi-
-atsoever, and wheresoever, which I also charge with the payment of
my said funeral expenses; and I hereby appoint Mr. Richard Player
to be sole executor of this my last will and Testament, and Trustee for
my said son untill of age. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 12th day of April 1771.
