And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give, devise and dispose of the same in the following manner to wit, First. I give and bequeath to Sarah, my dearly beloved wife, her residence on any part of my lands she may choose during her life, and her maintenance out of my personal estate untill my youngest child Rebecca be named be eighteen years of age, or the term of years if may be till then; at the expiration of which time, it is my will and desire that my personal estate be equally divided between my dearly beloved wife Sarah, and my well beloved children David Morgan, Daniel Morgan, Abel Morgan, Ezekiel Morgan, Benjamin Morgan, Sarah Morgan, Edward Morgan and Morgan, and a Rebecca Morgan.

Also I give to my well beloved son David Morgan one half of my survey of land whereon I now dwell, including the plantation. And unto my well beloved son Daniel Morgan, I give the other half of said survey of land, being the west end whereon is some cleared land.

I likewise constitute, make and ordain my well beloved sons David Morgan and Daniel Morgan Executors to this my last will and Testament, and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every other, former, testaments, wills, legacies, bequests and executors, by me in any ways before named, willed & bequeathed, ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this twenty third day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty two.
