 Herein I give my sons Samuel and Isaac Webb, whom I make sole
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament, I give, devise and
 bequeath to them and their heirs all my lands, goods and chattels
 after paying my legacies and just debts -

 18th day of July and the year of our Lord 1769 -

At October, Inferior Court 1769
 The within last Will and Testament of Daniel Webb deceased
 was produced to the Court, and moved in due form of law on
 the oath of Daniel Bradley a subscribing witness thereto, who swore
 that the testator was at the time of executing the same, to the best of
 his knowledge and belief of sound and disposing mind & memory &
 that Catharine Bradley signed at the same time as concurring wit-
 nessed to the same - And at the same time, Isaac and Samuel
 Webb, appeared and qualified as Executors to the within Will, in
 due form of law - ordered that letters testamentary issue accor-
 dingly -
