

In the name of God Amen. I David Jones of the County of New Hanover, and State of North Carolina, being of perfect mind and memory, calling to mind the mortality of my body, make this my last Will and Testament, my estate and effects I bequeath and dispose of in manner, and form following

First. I give and bequeath to my daughter, Susannah a negro man named Salmana, to her and her heirs and assigns forever, I also give and bequeath to my daughter, Rebecca the lands and plantation on which she now resides, and a negro girl named Hannah, to her and her heirs and assigns forever, I also give and bequeath my son David Jones 580 acres of land as will more fully appear by referring to a deed of gift bearing date the 3rd day of March 1786, made by me to him, I also give and bequeath to my daughter, Ann, a negro man named Joe, to her and her heirs and assigns forever, I also give and bequeath my son in law John Allan a negro boy named Sam, to him, his heirs and assigns forever

The residue and remainder of my estate, lands, tenements and hereditaments, with all other property to me appertaining or belonging, I give, devise and bequeath to my son William Jones who is my only son and heir at law, as appears by my last Will and Testament. And I do hereby declare and ratify this and no other, to be my last Will and Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three
