I, Eliza Dick, of the town of Wilmington, being weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory, do make and publish this as my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all others by me heretofore made.

I direct all recoverable debts, to be first paid.

I appoint William H. Halzey Executor to this my last Will and Testament.

I give and devise to William H. Halzey my Executor, all my estate real and personal, in trust, for the purpose of selling such part or portion of it as he may deem proper for the purpose of paying my debts, and to give sufficient title for the same; and the residue after the payment of my debts, I give and devise to William H. Halzey, in trust for the sole and separate use of my daughter, Martha, the wife of Zephaniah Spicer, without being subject to the debts or control of her husband; to have and to hold the same in trust as aforesaid, for the use of the said Martha Spicer and her heirs forever.
