I, Francis Harvey of New Hanover County, Province of North Carolina  
planter, being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and  
memory, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament,  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty eighth  
day of January one thousand seven hundred and seventy four

Item. I give to my nephew, John Walker, I give two sordel mares and one colt,  
but in case of the death of my said nephew before he attains the age  
of twenty one years, I in like manner give the said creatures to his  
father, William Walker

Item. To my brother, John Harvey, I give two mares and a young  
gray horse

Item. To my brother, Daniel Harvey, I give all the rest of my horses,  
mares and geldings

Item. I give all my stock of cattle to be equally divided between  
my brothers Daniel Harvey and John Harvey

Item. I give my stock of hogs to my said brother, Daniel Harvey

Item. The rest and residue of my estate, except my lands which  
I give to my brother, Daniel Harvey, I give and bequeath to my said  
brothers Daniel Harvey and John Harvey; but in case of the death of  
either of my said brothers before the attaining the age of twenty one  
years, I in like manner give the aforementioned legacies to the survivor

Lastly. I constitute and appoint my brothers William Walker, and Daniel  
Harvey, Executors of this my last will and testament, hereby ratifying  
and confirming this and no other as my last will and Testament,  
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty eighth  
day of January one thousand seven hundred and seventy four
