

In the name of God Armeid. I Henry Brooks of Wilmington being weak, in body, though of sound and disposing mind, memory, and understanding, prouise he to the disposing of all events, knowing the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the time thereof, drawe this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following.

I will and desire, that all my just debts and funeral charges be first duly paid and satisfied; then I will, devise and bequeath the rest and residue of my real and personal estate as follows, First -

I will and devise to Henry Blanca son of Joseph Blanca, one hundred pounds North Carolina currency, as soon as he shall attain the age of twenty one years -

Then I will, devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my real and personal estate to Allay Hirst, sister to Cornelius Hirst consisting of a house and lot in Front Street, a horse and lot in Henderson's Alley, a stable and lot in said alley, with whatever lands I am at present possessed of in the Country, together with four negroes, named Jack, Kit, Phillis and Lydia, some horses in the country, my household goods and furniture, with whatsoever debts may be legally and justly owing me -

Lastly. I nominate and appoint my true and worthy friend Cornelius Hirst, together with his sister, Allay Hirst, Executor and Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and disannulling all former, and other Will and Wills by me heretofore made, and ratifying and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament -

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twelfth day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety two -

New Hanover County The last Will and Testament of Henry Novr Second 1792 - Brooks was proved in open court by the oaths of Henry Dherbe, who swore he saw the testator sign, seal, publish and declare it to be and contain his last Will and Testament - At same time Cornelius Hirst therein named, qualified as Executor thereto -
