

In the name of God Amen. I Hezekiah Bonham
being of sound mind and memory, but weakly in body, do
make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner
as follows:

1st. I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Ann, all my
lands during her natural life, and all my estate real and
personal, and after her death, to be divided equally among
my heirs which may be surviving.

2^d. I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my son William
Bonham which is now dec^d, in addition to what I have
hitherto given him, Forty Shillings, which they are to receive
from the Executors at any time.

3rd. I constitute and appoint my very trusty and well
beloved Hezekiah and John Bonham sole Executors to this
my last Will and Testament.

Signed, sealed and delivered
in presence of us, this 30th day
of January 1819.
