

In the name of God Omnipotent. I Jepé Rook, of the State of North Carolina and County of New Hanover, being now aged but of sound mind and memory, thank be to God who gave me that blessing to make this my last Will and Testament, in manner as follows.

I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah, together with five negroes named Dolly, Lewis, Freacy, Hannah, & Sally, and all their increase, these I give and bequeath unto my wife Sarah at her own disposal forever, as I also give unto her, a negro man named Pompey during her natural life, and after, to be equally divided among myself children, that is Judah, Mary, Timothy, Beulah, Joseph & Benjamin, also unto my wife Sarah I give and bequeath my riding horse and wheeled carriage, and also my stock, of cows and hogs; and also I give and bequeath unto her a bed and furniture of her own choosing; and also I give and bequeath unto my wife the plantation where I now reside, containing five hundred acres, with the buildings and improvements on it, & after her death unto my son Benjamin with his paying from two hundred dollars unto my estate.

And also I give and bequeath unto Joseph my son four hundred acres of land altogether, viz one hundred and twenty less acres on the West side of Black river, and one hundred taking in the long bluff, and one hundred and eighty adjoining that of the long bluff, and one hundred between the Island & Mason's thoroughfare, with paying in unto my estate two hundred dollars and also I give and bequeath unto Beulah, my daughter, one hundred and fifty acres adjoining my land and George Moores, with paying in three hundred dollars in unto my estate.

And also I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca, her self, Rebecca, Judah and Thomas Sikes one hundred dollars each and unto John Sikes their father, I give and bequeath unto him five dollars.

Also I give and bequeath unto Martha my daughter, her self, Penny three hundred dollars.

And also I give unto my son in law Joshua Penny five dollars and also all the remaining part of my property that is not disposed of, to be equally divided among my six children, viz, Judah Pigford, Mary Boon, Timothy Rooks, Joseph Rooks, Beulah Moore and Benjamin H. Rooks.

And lastly. I constitute and appoint Benjamin H. Moore, John Pigford and Benjamin H. Rooks sole executor to this my last Will and Testament, In testimony whereof I have set my hand and seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1827.

ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form  
as follows. First. I will and ordain that my body be decently buried  
by my Executors.

Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Margaret  
all my crop of corn, in case sown before it is consumed, and all  
my stock, by cattle, and also all the rest and residue of my estate  
of whatever kind.

Lastly. I do nominate, constitute and appoint my worthy friends  
Patrick Murphy and James Heron Executors to this my last will  
and Testament, revoking all former wills by me made. I do by  
these presents declare this to be my last will and Testament.
