I John Corbett Senr, being of sound mind and memory, do make this my last Will and Testament in manner following First. I commit my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my children.

Secondly. I give and bequeath to my loving wife Francis Corbett my negro boy Bill, also my stock of cattle and hogs, during her natural life.

I give and bequeath to my daughter, Margaret Mulford my negro boy Jim.

I give my son John Corbett my negro boy Dick.

I give and bequeath to my son Charles B Corbett my negro boy Sam.

I also give and bequeath to my daughter, Elizabeth M Corbett my negro boy Abel.

After the death of my wife, I give to my daughters Margaret Mulford and Elizabeth M Corbett my two negroes Map & Bill, also to my two sons John & Charles B Corbett my negro girl Nancy, to be equally divided between them; provided that the above heirs shall pay each and her proportionable part of all debts by me contracted; disannulling and revoking all other Wills by me made.
