

I devise and bequeath my Mosley Hall lands in the County of New
Hanover, State of North Carolina, together with all my other property, both
real and personal wherever ^{including all debts & legal rights due & due} situate, unto I amble & she and Charles
P. Mallett, their heirs and assigns forever, to have and to hold upon
trust nevertheless and on this express condition, that my said
trustees will hold the property herein bequeathed and devised
to the sole and separate use, benefit and behoof of ^{the} said Caroline
Mary Walker, wife of Bartleton Walker, and of her children, until
such time as the now existing debts of Bartleton Walker, shall have
been by him discharged and satisfied; and then in trust and for
the use, benefit and behoof of the said Bartleton Walker, to whom
my said trustees may then convey it. And further my trustees
may permit the said Caroline Mary Walker, to receive and have to,
her sole and separate use, the rents and profits of my lands, the
dividends on my bank stock, and the hire of my negroes, until
such time as the trust estate as to her, shall be terminated; and
her receipt for them, shall be to them at all times a full & sufficient
discharge.

And I appoint my trustees herein named Executors of this my
last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any will by me her-
etofore made, Witness my name and seal this 25th day of October
1824

before execution, and the interlineation
on the seventh line also.
