In the name of God Amen. I, Joseph Newton Junior of
the County of New Hanover and State of North Carolina, being of perfect mind
and memory, do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament,
hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made and declaring this only
to be my last Will and Testament,

In witness. It is my will that all the property I am now seized and possessed
of, namely, two hundred acres of land in the County of New Hanover lying
on Federal Point, the same being in three several tracts, the land on which
I now live containing fifty acres, the land I purchased from John Holit containing
one hundred acres, which will more fully appear, by deed bearing date the 21st
day of April 1824; and fifty acres given to me by my father, on which Joseph
Newton Senior, now lives; together, with the following negro slaves, Matilda,
Aggy, Moses, Sylvia and Dick; together, with my household and kitchen
furniture, to be equally divided between my three children, to wit, William
Henry Newton, Henrietta Newton, and Edward Newton,

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my father, Edward Newton
and my brother, Edward Newton, Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th
day of October, in the year, of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and thirty two
