and perfect mind and memory, blest be God, calling
unto mind the mortality of my body, and knowing that
it is appointed unto all once to die, do make, constitute and
ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form
as follows. First. I will and order, that my body be decently buried
by my Executors.

Secondly. I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Margaret
all my crop of corn, in case I die before it is consumed, and all
my stock of cattle, and also all the rest and residue of my estate
of whatever kind.

Lastly. I do nominate, constitute and appoint my worthy friends
Patrick Murphy and James Kerr Executors to this my last Will
and Testament, revoking all former wills by me made, I do by
these presents declare this to be my last Will and Testament.
In witness whereof I Mary Robertson have hereunto set my hand
and seal. Dated 8th July 1827.
