Know all men by these

presents, That Bellary Smith of the State and County aforesaid doth give and bequeath unto my children, the following lots of land, as it was the request of my husband on his death bed, to give each one his lot of land he had left them off, all but my son John Smith and William Smith was to go to their children.

Whereas Bellary Smith the wife of the said Peter Smith deceased doth give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Smith the Lot No 1. 100 acres, beginning below the Mill and running S. 75° E 240 poles to a stake, thence N. 72° W 200 poles to a stake in a Savanna, thence a direct course towards the first, till it strikes the nearest branch, thence down said branch to the main branch, thence down said branch to the beginning, including the Mill in it.

I also devise and bequeath unto my grandson John Smith the son of my son John Smith, the lot No 2. 202 acres, beginning at a stake in a Savanna and running N. 72° W 208 poles to a pine, thence N. 30° E 80 poles to a stake, thence S. 72° E 110 it strikes the S. W. prong of the Mill branch, thence down the said branch to the fork, thence up the other prong to the first station.

I do also give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Smith the following Lot No 3. 94 acres, beginning at a pine the South side of the Main road and running N. 63° W 14 chains or 56 poles to a pine by a pond near Wm Gathers line, thence South 30° E 50 chains or 200 poles to a pine near John Motts line, thence South 72° E 102 chains or 408 poles to a stake, and thence with a straight line to the first station, which the lot No 4. contains the whole of the above mentioned lots; and the above lots contain six hundred and forty acres be the same more or less.

and I also do give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Smith, another piece of land lying and being in the County aforesaid, beginning at a pine by a pond near a path Moore's corner, and running N. 38 degrees East 400 poles to Smith's creek, thence across the creek at an old bridge South 55 degrees East 52 poles to a

small pine, thence South 45 degrees West 40 poles, thence South 15 degrees West 100 poles to Marsden Campbells land, thence with said land North 15 degrees West across Smiths Creek, 100 poles, thence along Moore's line to the beginning containing 60 acres; the above lot or piece of land I do give and bequeath peaceably and quietly and leavable from all claims of every person or persons; and I the said Mary Smith of State and County aforesaid, cloth give and bequeath unto the within named children, unto them, their heirs, assigns and administrators fully leavable and clearly forever, and ever.
