 Mind & Memory and taking into consideration the uncertainty
 of Life and the certainty of death do this day think proper
 to make and publish this my last will & Testament. Item
 I give & grant into my beloved wife own all of my property
 both real & personal of every denomination during her natural
 life for her use and benefit and after her death to be divided
 in the following manner to wit. I have a note and accounts
 against Beatty Sikes to the amount of forty seven dollars this
 Note & accounts I give to the heirs of the said Beatty Sikes (if on
 hand at the death of my wife) I give all my other personal property
 Consisting horses cattle hogs sheep crop household & kitchen furniture
 Cash Notes and accounts that may be on hand of Nine at the
 death of my wife to be divided between the heirs Jean McKee and
 the heirs Elizabeth Cartwright and the heirs of my Daughter
 Elizabeth Jane Ross. I have One Negro man Baloom that
 is old and nearly past service I give him (said Negg) with one
 half of my lands to Bryant Newkirk and the other half of my
 lands I give to James Kerr There shall be nothing so construed
 in this will as to deprive my wife the full use and benefit
 of all the property during her life time I do hereby nominate
 and appoint my worthy friend James Kerr executor to this
 my last will & Testament this the 17th day of October in the
 Year of our Lord 1844
