And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Joshua Wright my Executor to all intents & purposes to execute this my last will & Testament hereby writing and declaring utterly void all other wills & Testaments by me heretofore made

 it is my will that my land and negroes be equally divided
 between my daughter Margaret Montague & her issue it is
 my will that my executors have full power to prevent any
 person from carrying any of my negroes out of the state
 of North Carolina and it my wish that they prevent it
 And lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my trusty friends
 James Garrison and Samuel S. Herring my lawful executors
 to intents & purposes to execute this my last will & Testament
 according to the true intent and meaning of the same
