First, as to the disposition of the estate wherewith it hath pleased the Almighty to entrust me, I dispose of the same as followeth, -

Should it please Providence that I die without child or children the issue of my present marriage, then it is my will that my beloved wife should be the sole inheritrix of my estate of every description; should I die having issue as aforesaid, then my property to be divided and distributed as the law provides in the event of my dying intestate -

And further, as it respects the balance due me from Captain George Cameron, I bequeath the same to the children of said Cameron, provided I die without issue as aforesaid -

And lastly, I appoint Mr. Jesse Schmitt Senr and Mr. William McKay the executors of my will - In Witness whereof have set my hand and seal this 31th August 1815
