

In the name of God Amen. I, Richard Price of the
State of North Carolina and County of New Hanover, being sick
and weak of body, but of perfect mind and memory, and at
the same time calling to mind the uncertainty of human life, do
make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner
and form following.

1st. I recommend my soul to God that gave it me; and my body
to have decent and Christian burial at the discretion of my Ex-
ecutors hereafter, to be named.

2nd. I will and desire that all my just debts and funeral expenses
be paid by my said Executors.

3rd. I will and desire that my sister, Anne Jones have one negro
girl child named Rachel about three years old, to be hers and
her heirs forever.

4th. I will and desire that my sister, Sarah Jones have one negro
girl child named Nancy, about one year old, to be hers and
her heirs forever.

5th. My Will and desire is that my brother, James Price do
have, and I hereby do give and bequeath unto him, all the
residue of my estate real and personal, to him and his heirs
forever.

6th. I nominate, constitute and appoint my said brother,
James Price, and James Kenan Esquire of Duplin County to be
my Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking
all other wills and testaments by me heretofore made.
In witness whereof I the said Richard Price have hereunto set
my hand and seal at Fayetteville the 19th day of November, Anno
Domini 1791.
