to this my last will reposing in him my entire Confidence


Item 2^d I give and devise to my dear little Children

in the Town of Wilmington of which my husband William
Eason died seized and possid

Item 3^d I wish my Executor to sell all my personal and
personal property of every kind and description and the
proceeds thereof to be appropriated to the payment of my
Just debts and it is my wish and desire that in case the
proceeds from the sale of my personal property should not
be sufficient to pay my debts then I want my Executor
to sell only as much of my interest in the before mentioned
and devised lots or parcels of lands as in his Judgment
he may think best and appropriate the proceeds or as
much as should be necessary to pay all my Just debts
and if there should be any money or funds remaining
in the hands of my Executor I give and bequeath it to
my before mentioned Children share and share alike

It is my wish & desire that my body shall be decently
buried
