daughter, Sarah Rowd, a negro woman by the name of Filler,
and her daughter, Minnie,

I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Larkins, all my share
of the Stock, household and kitchen furniture and plantation tools.

I further give to my son William R Larkins, Five dollars.

I also give to my son in law James Rowd one dollar.
