

I, Thomas Henderson of the town of Wilmington, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following, vizt,
 I give and bequeath to Miss Ann Evans daughter of William and Mary Evans of the town aforesaid, one tract or parcel of land in Bladen County, containing three hundred and twenty acres more or less.
 Next. It is my desire that the remainder of my whole estate both real and personal may be divided in five equal parts one of which part or moiety to be given to my brother Andrew Henderson; another part to my sister, Catharine Gotterson, a third part to my sister, Isabella Henderson, a fourth part to my sister, Lucia Henderson, and the fifth part or moiety to be equally divided among the children of my sister, Jane Surice, share and share alike.

And I hereby appoint and nominate my trusty friends A. Chughton and William Evans and Thomas Owen my Executors, this 10th November, 1787.
