

State of Virginia. County of Stafford March Eleventh 1862

I will bid Croon a private in Company C. first Regt
infantry of North Carolina State Troops and from the County of
Kinston and State of North Carolina. Stationed at Camp
Bee in Stafford County in the State of Virginia being of
sound mind and body, but considering the uncertainty of
life, and desirous of disposing all my worldly possession
both real and personal to such persons as I desire
to have the same, do make this my last will and
testament. I desire and request that my Executor
to be him of the named, shall in case of my being
killed, seek out and if possible find my body and carry
it to my native County in the State of North Carolina
and then to bury it in my Father's grave yard being
and situated on the land belong to my Father minor
him.

I desire also that my Executor shall out of the
monies due me from different persons, pay all lawful
and just claims, that day and every person may have
or hold against me. I direct that all my real and

personal estate of whatever description, save and
except my Negroes or Slaves, shall be sold to the
highest at public auction, and that money or proceeds
derived therefrom, shall at the expiration of six
months from the date of said sale, be equally di-
vided between my Brothers Jeppe Croone, Joel Croon
and my Sisters Catharine Moore wife of Isaac Moore
and Susan Dawson wife of Josiah Dawson. I desire
also that the sale of the above mentioned property, shall
take place three weeks after my death, or as soon
after as it is convenient or possible, desiring my Ex-
ecutor to use his best judgment with regard to said
sale.

I desire that my Negroes or Slaves, shall be
lived out from year to year, at public auction to the
highest bidder he giving good and sufficient security for
the same, and the said Negroes or Slaves to be thus
lived out until such time as my youngest brother
Joel Croon shall have arrived at the age of twenty
one years. Then at that time or as soon as possible
the said Negroes or Slaves and their issue together with
the money or proceeds of their hire be equally divided
share and share alike between my Brother Jeppe Croon
Joel Croon and my Sisters Catharine Moore wife of
Isaac Moore and Susan Dawson wife of Josiah
Dawson. I nominate and appoint Aaron W
Lane as my Executor, and desire and request
him to do and act as such. Witness my hand

and seal this eleventh day of March in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and fifty two

Surry County Court June Term 1864.

A paper writing purporting to be the last Will & Testament of William Croom deceased is exhibited in open Court and offered for probate by John Jones, and the due execution thereof is proved by oaths of O. Fennell Jr one of the Subscribing Witnesses thereto, and as such considered by the Court to be and contain the last will and Testament of Wm Croom, and sufficient to convey the property therein in signature & further apprising to the satisfaction of the Court that A Mr Squall the Executor therein named is dead. John Jones was therefore duly qualified as administrator of said Croom with the will annexed, by taking the oath prescribed by law. Let the same be recorded and filed -

of the State of North Carolina and of Surry County,
being of sound mind and good memory, blessed be
God do this 16th of December in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two
make and publish this my last will and Testament
in manner following, that is to say, I give to the
heirs of little Susan Davis Applewhite deceased fifty
dollars to be equally divided among them, and
to Sister Wilson W Prudger wife of James W Prudger
I give all my Negroes, and lands, stock, of all
kinds, & slaves held and retained furniture, to
hold her lifetime, and then to go to the heirs of
her body. My just debts and funeral expenses
to be paid first of all and then the balance to be
divided as I have above written.
And I hereby make and Ordain my friend James
R Corbett Executor of this my last will & Testament
as witness whereof I the said John W Marshall here
