I William Herring of the County of New Hanover and  
 State of North Carolina Being of sound Mind & memory  
 but Considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do  
 make and publish this my last will & testament in manner  
 and form following that is to say that is to say that my  
 Executors hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent  
 burial suitable to the wishes of my relations and friends  
 and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts  
 however and to whom soever owing out of the monies that  
 may just come into their hands as a part or parcel of my  
 estate Item I give and devise to my daughter Margaret  
 Montague all of my land and all of my Negroes and all  
 of my stock of Cattle & hogs & sheep & horses except one cow  
 and Calf all of my house hold & kitchen furniture except one  
 Bed & furniture or the remainder after paying my just  
 debts also my Baroach & wagon & Slatkey Item 2. I give to  
 my Cousin Susan Herring One Cow & Calf as good as in my  
 stock & one good bed of furniture to have & to hold to her the  
 said Margaret Montague land & Negroes stock & furniture  
 for and during the term of her natural and at her death  
 it is my will that my land and negroes be equally divided  
 between my daughter Margaret Montague & her issue it is  
 my will that my executors have full power to prevent any  
 person from carrying any of my negroes out of the state  
 of North Carolina and it my wish that they prevent it  
 And lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my trusty friends  
 James Garrison and Samuel S. Herring my lawful executors  
 to intents & purposes to execute this my last will & Testament  
 according to the true intent and meaning of the same

and every part and clause thereof hereby Prokelytized  
declaring utterly void all other wills & Testaments by me heretofore  
made.

In Witness whereof I the Said William Herring do hereunto set  
my hand & seal this the 30th day of December in the year  
of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty six  
Signed sealed published & declared  
by the said W<sup>m</sup> Herring to be his last  
Will & Testament in the presence of
