I William Murford being weak in body, but of perfect memory, thanks be to God for the same, and knowing the uncertainty of this life, that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament, renouncing all other, Wills and acknowledgins this to be my last Will and Testament, and whereas it hath pleased God to bless me with such worldly endowments, I give and bequeath in manner, and form following, Item. I give and bequeath unto my brother, Charles Murford, ten shillings sterling, and unto Ann Murford my beloved wife, whom I make my sole executor, all my lands, cattle, hogs, horses, and every thing that I possess, after my lawful debts is paid.

I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God my Saviour, and Redeemer, in whom and by the merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour, I trust and believe myself to be saved and to have full remission and forgiveness of all my sins, and that my soul with my body at the general day of the resurrection, shall rise again with joy, and through the merits of Christ's death and passion, possess the kingdom of heaven; and for my body to be buried at the discretion of my wife above named.
