In the name of God Amen.

The fourteenth day of March 1743. I William Reiley, in the County  
of New Hanover, Planter, being very sick and weak in body, but  
of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given unto God therefor  
calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it  
is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last  
will and Testament, that is to say principally and first of all -

I give and recommend my soul to the hands of God that gave it,  
and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent chris-  
tian burial at the discretion of my executors, nothing doubting but  
at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty  
power of God, and as touching such worldly estate wherewithal it's  
hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give, devise, and dispose  
of the same in the following manner and form -

I give and bequeath to my son John Reiley, one plantation  
lying upon the other side of the creek joining to Art. Tony  
and I give to my son Edward Reiley the plantation and land Art.  
Tony, and he must give to his brother John Reiley thirty pounds sterling  
then I give to my dearly beloved wife Mary Reiley this plantation to  
live upon until her son Edward be of age -

and I give to my two sons William Reiley and Bartholomew the three  
negroes named Beazy, Ned and Meriam, to be laid out to the  
best advantage.

I give to my dearly beloved wife all the moveables -

I likewise constitute, make and ordain Mr. Roger Moore Esq and Mr. George Moore Esq my sole executors of this my last Will and Testament; and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every other former, Wills and Testaments, Legacies and Requests and Executors, by me in any way before named, written and bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament.

In the name of good Council. I Alexander Ross of Wilmington in the Province of North Carolina, Sailor, being sick, and weak, in body, but of sound mind, memory and understanding do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following.

First of all. It is my will and desire that all my just debts, funeral expenses be well and duly paid and satisfied; and in order to enable my Executors to discharge my said debts, and to prevent my estate being torn to pieces after my decease, I do hereby require them to collect my debts with all convenient speed.

Item. I give, devise and bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife Elizabeth Ross and to her heirs and assigns forever, all my estate that I shall die possessed of both real and personal to her only and sole use benefit and behoof forever,

And I hereby nominate and appoint my said wife Executrix, and my friends John Burgwin and Henry Toomee of Wilmington Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills or wills by me heretofore made, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of May A.D. 1744.
