1st Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Susan Jane Wilson and the lawful heirs of her body Three hundred & twenty acres of land more or less where I now reside on.

2^d Item I give and bequeath to my son William S Walker all the out of the lands now known as the crane tree piece and the landing piece containing about three hundred & fifty acres, be the same more or less.

In testimony whereof I the said William Walker have hereunto set my hand and seal this 22^d day of February A.D. 1851
