In the Name of God Amen. I James Atherton of the State of North Carolina, Northampton County, being in low State of Health but of sound disposing mind and memory thanks be given unto God for ye same do make & ordain this my last will & testament In manner & Form following.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Penelope Branson one Negro man named Tom. one negro woman named Pa Line, also one named Sue another named Hatt & another negro girl named Deborah, one Horse by ye name of Gaspar, and one bed of furniture. I also give unto her the profits of a Half Share of land lying being in Island of Barrenuda which I Reserve to the said Deborah. In ye year one seven hundred Sixty one for which I have not received an Accounting of all lands, she being by law & only Heir to the same being

bequeath from Peter Prudore of the Island, ye aforesd articles I give to her, her heirs forever.

I give & bequeath to John Atherton Dawson one Negro girl named Tomps & one negro boy named Sam being a child of both to him his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to Charity Dawson one Negro girl named Doring to her other heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath to John Dawson one Negro girl called by ye name of Linda, a child of Linda mother by ye name Anthony from th<sup>e</sup> which to her in this heirs for ever.

Item I give unto my Daughter Dorothy Dawson one Negro fellow named Will which she have named, one Negro boy by ye name of Rufus one Negro woman by the name of Sitt & such articles as she have left to her Receiver of me, to her other heirs for ever.

Item I give unto Francis Atherton Bynum one Negro fellow named Jacob, one Negro girl named Amy a daughter of Martha to him this heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto Dorothy Bynum son of my daughter Mary Bynum one Negro girl named Lydia a child of Nelly, & one Negro girl named Esther a daughter of Amy to her other heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Bynum one Negro woman named Nelly & one child Mary also one Negro horse named Saddle & Bridle bed & furniture to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Temperance Atherton, one Negro fellow named Henry one Negro Minch named Galinda one girl named Cressie one No Ceatah one do Hester also one boy by the name of Frank. I also give to my Daughter Temperance, one feather bed of furniture and saddle & Bridle that she has now ye command of it also it is my desire that she have a sensible horse of a bairt treantly fine value, the same to be in gold or silver with her

Item before which I give to her other heirs for exec.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Frances Atherton one Negroe Lad named Nelson, & a Bo. Named little Peter, one Negroe wench named Sissy one do named Fannie, one negro boy named Stephen one Bo Name or Anthony also it is my desire that she may have a horse Bridle Saddle at about Twenty five pounds value in gold or Silver, also our bed, & four niture, the same to be delivered when she comes to lawful age or Marriage, also I give the above said to her other heirs for exec.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Sipe Atherton all of lands that I am possessor with containing the tract I bought of Barnabas Thomas one do I bought of Mr. Cowper so tract which said tract the Court have now made me also one tract I bought of Bennet Hill lying in ye Meadows, also one tract I bought of Mr. Allen Jones lying in ye Georgetown bush containing three hundred & fifty acres, and also all ye negroes that I am possessor with excepting seven that I have heretofore given away Viz. John Mary, Alice, James that I bought of Fannie Rigney Duke, Mrs. George Bob, Austin, Jeffry, Aaron Bryant, that I bought of Mr. Wm. Hincher & Hill that I bought of Mr. Vaughan, Graw & Lucy, Simon & Simon, Smith, Amy Cherry Cato, Mrs. Charlotte, and all ye rest of my whole Estate Stock of all kinds bonds notes debts dues & demands of any kind whatsoever. It is also my desire that my debts be paid out of the Estate, left in so clause if otherwise is that my wife should be handsomely maintained out of the remaining part of my son Sipe Atherton's Estate during her natural life, she above so desiered I give to my son Sipe Atherton his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby appoint

my wife Betsy Atherton & John Dawson my half Sole Executress of this my last Will & Testament, signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us this 19<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1787.

Item I give and bequeath to my son John Edwards, five plates and a large dish one great Pot and one feather bed upon

Item I give and bequeath to my son Isaac Edwards four plates and one small Dish one iron Pot one chest one feather bed after my decease

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Siley Edwards four plates and a bed

Item I give to my son Stewart Edwards five Shillings Proclamation money and no more.

Item I give to my Daughter Mary Chancell five Shillings Proclamation money and no more.
