 County in the province of Carolina being sick
 of sound mind & memory do make constitute appoint &
 ordain this my last will & Testament in manner &
 form following, Item I give devise bequeath unto
 my son Jacob Bap one negro Girl named Bleck
 her increase, Item I give devise bequeath unto my
 son Isaac Bap two negro women named Rose & Nell &
 their increase one feather bed & furniture & a mare Colt
 called pleasant, Item I give devise bequeath unto my
 grand son John Bap son of Isaac Bap a negro girl
 named Fanny & her increase, Item I give devise bequeath
 unto my son Abraham Bap one negro Girl named
 Phillis & her increase, Item I give devise bequeath unto
 my grand son Job Bap one negro Girl named
 Gunther & her increase & one feather bed & furniture
 Item I give devise bequeath unto my grand son Coan
 el Bap son of Jethro Bap my land & plantation
 wherein I now do live containing two hundred acres
 more or less my negro fellow named Sharper my
 still & a negro boy named Reuben to
 him his heirs & assigns forever, Item I give devise bequeath
 unto my grand son Uriah Bap son of Drury my land &
 plantation wherein the said Drury now lives contain-
 ing one hundred Acres more or less joining Duckham
 Branch and Maps & also the half of my land
 lying in Neraka Swamp joining Cole Bays one line
 also a negro woman named Hannah & her increase
 hereafter also a negro boy named Bone to him his
 heirs & assigns forever Item I give devise bequeath
 unto my daughter Abigail one negro woman

name *Leah* & her increase also one negro boy named *Pemby*
 Item I bind unto my daughter *Uriah* *Cannell* the use
 of one negro woman named *Henah* & her increase during
 his life & at her decease I give *Uriah* *Thigmath* the said
 negro woman *Henah* & her increase apportion to be equally
 divided between or amongst her children,

Item I give devise bequeath unto my Grand son *Joseph*
Brattle son of *John Brattle* the Land & plantation
 wherein the said *John Brattle* now containing two
 hundred acres more or less bounded on an agreed
 line already made also one hundred acres of land
 adjoining my son *Joshua*'s land an agreed line
 already made and joining *Charles Bryan* *Stinson*
 also fifty acres of land I purchased of *John*
Herry according to the most known & respected
 bounds thereof also one negro girl named *Jane*
 and her increase to him his heirs & assigns forever

Item I give devise & bequeath unto my Grand daughter
Abigail *Brattle* one negro boy named *Dan*,

Item I give unto my Grand son *John Brattle* one negro
 girl & her increase named *Patt*. Item I give unto
 my Grand daughter *Margret* *Brattle* one negro
 girl named *Rebeckah* & her increase. Item I give
 devise & bequeath unto my Grand son *Drury* *Brattle*
 one negro boy named *Sham*, Item I give unto
 my daughter *Elizabeth* *Brattle* one negro woman
 named *Jessie* & her increase hereafter

Item I give devise & bequeath all the remainder of my estate
 that is not in my will given away to be equally divided
 between or amongst my children namely, *Leah*
John, *Abraham*, *Isaac*, *Joshua*, & *Drury* *Bap*. *His*
carp *Madew*, *Cannell*, and *Elizabeth* *Brattle* between
 to them their heirs & assigns forever.

Item I do hereby Ordain constitute & appoint my estate
 friend *John Hunt* my son *John Bap* and *Richard*

Vial my whole whole Executors of this my last
 will & testament hereby disavowing & making null
 & void all former wills & testaments by me heretofore
 made & this only to be my last will & testament, In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this four
 teenth day of June one thousand seven hundred

John Boykins Will

In the name of god I shew *John Boykins* of
N. Carolina in *Northampton County* being in perfect
 sense & memory do and Ordain this my last will & testament
 in Ordinance as follows.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son *John Boykins* the
 plantation he now lives on the land I bought
 of *Thomas* *Shank* the land lying between the two
 tracts of this side to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son *Barrell* *Boykins* he
 now lives on and all the lands belonging to it now a
 survey of land joining of the land that he lives on
 and bounded on the South side and *Shank* in a
 plantation I bought of *Charles* *Longstreet* lying
 in *Carter* *Hole* to him and his heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son *John* *Boykins* the
 plantation I now live on after the death of
