

Wm Bridges Will

In the name of God Amen. I Wm Bridges of Northampton County in the Province of North Carolina being very sick Weak but thanks be to almighty God of sound & disposing mind & memory and Calm in mind the uncertainty of this transitory life am willing to make my will, first begin with my soul to almighty God that gave it me, and my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors and as touching my worldly estate that hath pleased almighty God to bless me with. I give & bequeath as followeth that is to say.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Edward Bridges my plantation where in I now live, and all the lands therunto belonging also the Swamp land purchased of James Bryant, the said plantation & the lands besides, to him & his heirs forever only my loving wife Faith to hold them during her widowhood, also one feather bed of furniture & one gun.

Item I give to my son William Bridges my negro man named Simon, my negro man Harpo, & my negro boy Tony, also one feather bed of furniture to him & his heirs forever.

Item I give unto my daughter Sarah Bridges my negro girl called Nara she shall have one feather bed of furniture to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give to my daughter Purity Bridges my negro girl called Beck she shall have one feather bed of furniture to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give unto my loving wife Faith Bridges my negro man named Ned, my negro woman called Quiah, & my negro woman called Pat they & their increase to her & her heirs forever, also all the remaining part of my personal estate not before given & for bringing up my said children, & their schooling & learn her the labor of my said slaves that are given to my children till the arrival at age or marriage.

I do nominate & appoint my loving wife Faith Bridges my executrix & Wm Ruffin & Wm Nix, for executors of my will. I give to my last will & testament, speaking & signing

all persons able by me made, & this I own to be my last. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal my seal this fourteenth day of September, one thousand seven hundred and sixty three.

The preceding will of Wm Bridges and was exhibited into Court, and proven on the oath of James Lapiter one of the subscribers witnesses thereto, at the same time Faith Bridges & Wm Nix were qualified Executors & Executors thereof, which on motion was ordered to be certified & recorded.

Francis Graves Will

In the name of God Amen. I Francis Graves of Northampton County & Province of North Carolina being sick Weak of body but of perfect mind & memory do make this my last will & testament in manner & form following.

Item My will & desire is that all my just debts & funeral expenses be paid, after which the remainder of what I shall have and the almighty God to bestow upon me, I dispose of in following manner.

Item I leave to my loving wife Mary, Graves the use of my whole estate during her widowhood, and if my dear wife should survive then immediately after which my will is that my whole estate should be equally divided between my wife & my children, which I did provision of my estate I give to my wife & children & heirs.

I do hereby nominate & appoint my loving wife executrix of this my last will, James Lapiter of Sampson County set my hand & seal this twenty seventh day of October Anno Domini 1763.
