Britain Brittle Mile

In the name of God amen I Brodian Brittle of the County of Northampton in the State of North Carolina knowing that it is against and for all men one to day I do make this my last will & testament as follows.

Then I give the Quaker to my wife Sarah one mare & Colt under one
one bridle saddle one bed & furniture & if in case my wife
Sarah should marry my slave & desire is that the said said
Negroes fall to misis yoh Brown to him this time forever

And my further Will & Desire I do appoint & give Breith my
Whole sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament.
as aforesaid. I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 18th
February, 1784.

I Robert Peck of Northampton County in North
Carolina being aged & infirm of body although believed
be the all wise disposer of all things, of sound and
disposing mind & memory & calling to my mind that is
appointed to men unto to die, do make & ordain this
my last Will & Testament in manner & form
following, namely: -

Firstly: I give & bequeath unto each of my five blessed children, viz. Robert & Isaac Bell, Elizabeth Bryan, Mary Annowill & Sarah Newson whatever they are already possessed of out of my estate to each of them their heirs and assigns forever.

Stew. - It is my Will & desire that all my Negroes, to wit: James,
Ben & Cassie, Dinah & her four children viz, my Sister Molly
Simms, Fessie & all the increase of the s^d Dinah & her four
children if any, they shall have their freedom if ever the
Laws of the Land should admit of their having that privi-
lege freely, clearly & absolutely, until which time it is
my Will & desire & I do hereby give & bequeath unto my
five children at once named my two Negroes James and
Ben, & that the profits arising from their labor be equally
divided ^{among} them - provided they don't sell hire or remove them
remote from their wives or contrary to their choice -

I then give and bequeath unto my son David Peck & my son in
Law Cornelius Tutland and my Daughter Judith,
Rachel & Celia my six Negroes, Cadmus, Arthur, Dinah,
Molly, Anne, Teresa and their increase if any to be equal
= by divided according to value unto them their heirs, assigns,
until the days above said of their freedom -

Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Newson one
Bed & furniture to her & heirs forever -

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter a shawl & a shawl
box & my sewing box & to her & at her disposal -

And I give & bequeath unto my two daughters Rachel & Maria
