Jure of the County of Northampton of the province of N.C.
of and province of North Carolina being of perfect
mind and memory thanks be to Almighty God and
Calling to remembrance the uncertainty of
Human Life and all flesh must yield to death
do make Constitution and ordain this my last
will and Testament in manner and form
following first I recommend my self to God
who gave me and my body to be buried in a
discreet Christian Burial at the discretion of my

posing what Temporal Estate it hath pleased God to
bestow me with I have devised I dispose in manner
and form following:

and Drury Osberry whereunto I have set my hand
and seal this 2 day of Decr 1775 Signed sealed and

Harmon Jarver's Will

In the name of God Amen I Harmon Jarver of the County
Northampton in North West Parish living in good health
thanks be to God but duly Considering that it is approp-
riated and for all men to die do make this my last will
and Testament in manner and form as follows I think
proper as for my worldly Estate when with it hath pleased
God to bless me with I give and dispose of the
same as followeth first I give and bequeath the use
of my Plantation whereon I now dwell contain-
ing one hundred acres of land thereto belonging
to the same more or less to my youngest son Robert
Jarver to him and his heirs forever. Secondly I give
to my son Frederick Jarver my Negro Boy Charles
to him and his heirs forever likewise my mare
to my son Frederick Jarver also with my Negro
