I also desire that the whole of my estate remaining may be sold in ready specie & be & remain in the hands of my Executors here after mentioned until David Wilson son of Wm. Wilson deceased arrives to the age of twenty years, then the Principle I give the quarter unto David Wilson son of Wm. Wilson deceased to him his heirs & assigns forever also my will & desire is that if the said David Wilson die before he arrives to the age of twenty years or has lawful issue that it should be equally divided between Margaret Ingram & Sarah Mitchell their their heirs & assigns forever And I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint James Wilson to execute this my last will & testament & I do hereby acknowledge this to be my last will & testament making all former wills & wills by me heretofore made this 26<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1781. In the name of God Amen, I the said Bryan being weak but in perfect sound mind memory thanks be given to God, & being of sound that I must owe due to I recommend my soul in the hand of almighty God who gave it my soul is that all my just debts should be paid in a convenient time after my decease & as touching my worldly Estate I do give & bequeath it in the manner & form as follows

 Item I give the quarter unto my Son Saml Bryan all my whole Estate of what so ever kind & sort my stock of Sheep & feathered seed & furniture

whom I now live which I give to my Son Benj Bryan the same forever & alway wearing clothes I give the quarter to my loving Daughter Catharine Woodly to her her heirs & assigns forever

Witnessing & appointing my loving Son Saml Bryan to be my true & only executor, Reserving & making utterly void all other wills by me heretofore made in testimony hereof I have hereunto set my hand & signed my seal signed sealed & published & pronounced this 6<sup>th</sup> day of Decr 1777.

### Richard Pratts Will

In the name of God Amen, the eighteenth day March 1781 I Richard Pratt of Northampton County State of North Carolina being of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God for the same, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & testament First of all give & recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it to my body & recommend to the care of the benevolent at the discretion of my exors, & Touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with I give & devise in & bequeath of the same in the following manner & form

Impremis I give the quarter unto my Son John Pratt the plantation whom my mother formerly lived & part of my other Plantations as far as my Spring from thence up a branch that is situate to Benja Joffers land fifty acres of land in Hally Passon, I likewise give my 12 John Pratt the whole of my Smith tools to him this heris forever.

Item I give the quarter to my Son Wm Bridges the plantation whom I now live, & all the rest of the lands that I am possessed with also my third hand mill to him this heris forever

Item I give the quarter unto my Sister Particular Jollyff Jean Round in full & clear of all manner of my worldly Estate & I do desire that she will give my Sister she maintain a use out of my Estate
