and discharged. Secondly I give and bequeath
unto my son William Griffith the sum of
four Shillings Lawful money of great Britain
Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my daughter
Martha Shepherd the sum of five Shillings
lawful money of great Britain Fourthly I
give and bequeath unto my grandson John Griffith
the sum of twenty Shillings current money of
Virginia Fifthly I give and bequeath unto my
grand daughter Hannah Griffith the sum
of twenty Shillings current money of Virginia
Sixthly I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter

Ninetieff Griffith to the sum of twenty Shillings
 Current of Virginia. Secondly I give and bequeath
 unto my grandsons Nathaniel Griffith the sum of
 twenty Shillings Virginia Current Eightty I give
 and bequeath unto my grandsons Russell Griffith
 twenty Shillings Current money of Virginia
 Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my grand Daughter
 Ann Griffith the sum of twenty Shillings Current
 money of Virginia. Fourthly all the rest and residue
 of my Estate of what nature or kind ever and
 wheresoever the same may be found I give and
 bequeath unto my friend William Weatherston
 in trust for the use of my Daughter Shephard
 during her Natural life and for no other intent
 use or purpose whatsoever and after the death
 of my said Daughter Martha Shephard
 what shall then remain of my Estate I give and
 bequeath the same unto all my grand Children
 and my wife and devise is that it shall be
 sold at public sale and the money arising
 therefrom to be equally divided amongst all
 my grand children that shall be then living
 Eleventhly and lastly I recommend and constitute and
 appoint my friend William M. Abington
 Executor of this my last will and testament hereby
 revoking all former wills and Testaments by me
 made I witness whereof I have set to my hand
 and seal the 28 day of November in the year
 of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and
 seventy two and in the twentieth year of the Reign
 of our sovereign Lord George the Third by the Grace
 of God King of Great Britain &c.

five shillings to him and his heirs forever
5. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary
Luter five shillings to her and her heirs forever
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter

Martha Webb five shillings to her and her heirs
forever 6. I give and bequeath unto my son Peter
Webb One bed and furniture to be his at my death
also One horse saddle and saddle bag at the age
of twenty years also my will and desire is
that my son Peter should be Raised and Clothed
Out of my Estate by my son Elisha Webb I give
and bequeath unto my son Elisha Webb all the
rest of my Estate Real and personal after paying
all my Just debts and the before given Legacies to
to him and his heirs forever and I do hereby appoint
my said son Elisha Webb Executor of this my last
will and testament and conforming this to be
my last will and Testament signed with my
hand and Sealed with my seal this 11 day of
January 1778.
