and lastly I do nominate and appoint my 3 beloved daughters Sarah Leach & my friend William Stephens & also my whole Wife Executors & Executors of this my last will & Testament In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 11th day of November 1759.

 - Item I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Bramly Caroline Brown five pounds Current money of King to her & he. heirs forever.
 - Item I give & bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mary Anne Sanders five ^{pounds} Current money of Virginia to her & he. heirs forever.
 - Item I give & bequeath unto my Grand daughter Louisa Sanders - to Daughter of William Lancaster Sarah his wife my my boy named Sterling to her & he. heirs forever.
 - Item I give & bequeath unto my son Henry West my four negroes named Kate, Glorah, Lemmy & Baire & their increase from this time, with all the remainder of my Estate both in & out without to him & he. heirs forever.
- Sadly I do hereby Recommend & ordain and appoint my son Henry West my sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament hereby making and making null & void all former Wills by me made & this only to be my last will & Testament hereby ratifying & confirming the same.
