Thomas Hart Will

In the name of God Amen. I Thomas Hart of Northampton County in the Province of North Carolina being at present very sick & weak of body, therefore calling to mind the mortality of my body, but of perfect sound mind & memory, thanks be to God, do constitute & ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form following that is to say first & principally I commit my soul into the hands of God, hoping to have full & free pardon & forgiveness of all my sins & to inherit everlasting life, and as for my body I commit it to the ground to be buried in a christianlike decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named and touching all such temporal Estate as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I give & dispose thereof as followeth.

Item I give & bequeath unto my living wife Anne Hart the labor of my negro fellow named Robin during her natural life, and after her decease the said Negro to be equally divided between my two sons Hardy Hart & Arthur Hart. I also give unto my living wife Anne Hart six head of Cattle two cows & two year old Calves & one cow & calf and the rest of my Cattle to be equally divided between

my two sons Harry & Arthur. I also give unto my loving wife right Shotes & one saw & right furr. I also give unto my wife my Hener saddle & bridle. I also give the use of two feather beds and furniture to them belonging unto my wife during her life and after her decease I give one of them to my Daughter Sarah Brykin and the other to my son Arthur Hart.

Item I give to my son Harry Hart right Shotes.

Item I give Shigumath to my son Arthur Hart two saws & one furr.

Item I give the residue & remainder of my estate to be equally divided between my two sons Harry & Arthur.

Item I give Shigumath unto my son Thomas Hart one Shilling.

Item I give Shigumath unto Francis Deloach one Shilling.

Item I give Shigumath unto my Sonnes one Shilling.

Item I give Shigumath unto William Hart one Shilling.

Item I give Shigumath unto Martha Smith one Shilling.

Item I give Shigumath unto my Grand son Warren Hart my Gun.

Item I give Shigumath unto my Daughter Sarah Brykin two chairs & my two other Chairs I give unto my wife.

Item I give unto my son Arthur Hart my Iron wedge & my Stilliards & Pew there to belonging.

Item I give the use of all the residue of my estate to my wife during her life & after her decease to be equally divided between my two sons Harry & Arthur & my Daughter Sarah Brykin and I do nominate & appoint my loving son Arthur Hart my whole & sole executor of this my last will & Testament & revoking & annulling & making void all other wills heretofore by me made, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 19th day of May 1761.
