Harmon Hills Will

In the Name of God amen I Harmon Hills of the
County of Northampton in the Province of North Carolina
being at present very Sick and weak of body but of
perfect sound mind and memory thanks be to God
therefor but Caring to mind the Mortality of my Body
do Constitue and Ordain this my Last Will & Testament
in Manner and Form following that is to say first &
principally, I Commend my Soul into the hands of almighty
God as gave it & as launching all such Temporal Estate
as it hath pleased almighty God to bestow upon me &
give and Dispose thereof in Manner of Form following-

I give and Bequeath unto my Son Henry Hills six Negroes
Hereafter mentioned to wit Lenny Leana Sevier Easter &
Senor to him & his heirs forever

I give & Bequeath unto my Son Harmon Hills three Negroes
Hereafter mentioned to wit Sam^r Cate & Munday & my land &
plantation whereon I now Live & still to him & his heirs forever.

I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Fanny Hills four Negroes
Hereafter mentioned to wit Rachel Ellen Fells Miles & 3 Cows & also
one feather bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever

I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Jean Hills five
Shillings to her & her heirs forever.

I give & Bequeath unto Harmon Saver four Shillings
to him & his heirs forever

I give & Bequeath unto Martha Marden five Shil-
lings to her & her heirs forever.

I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Martha Lewis

five Shillings to her & her heirs forever

I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Betta Webb five
Shillings to her & her heirs forever

I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Stella Hart five Shillings
to her & her heirs forever

I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Sweet five Shillings
to her & her heirs forever

I send unto my wife Elizabeth Hills the use & benefit of three
Negroes hereof. Munchona Sammel Old & Kage & all the
rest of my Estate that is not mentioned before which Henry
Hills Com^r of age & my Will is that then it should be equally
divided between my two sons Henry Hills to him & his heirs for
ever & my son Harmon Hills to him & his heirs forever & my
wife Elizabeth Hills during her Natural Life & after her
decease to be equally divided between my two sons & then
and this heirs forever and I do Constitue and appoint
my Beloved wife Elizabeth Hills my son Henry Hills and
Thomas Hart my Heirs and sole Executors of this my Last Will
& Testament nothing disannulling and making void all
other Wills herebefore made by me in as much as heretofore I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this day of January 1772.
