In the Name of God amen I Harmon Will of the
County of Northampton in the Province of North Carolina
being at present very sick and weak of Body but of
perfect sound mind and memory thankes be to God
therefor but Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body
do constitute and ordain this my last Will & Testimony
in Manner and Form following that is to say first
Principally I Command my Soul into the hands of almighty
God as gave it & accounting all such Temporal Estates
as it hath pleasd almighty God to bestow upon me I
give and dispose thereof in Manner & Form following

Yours I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Hill the Negro
hereafter mentioned & his family & wife during Easter &
Christmas to him & his heirs for ever.

From I give & bequeath unto my son Hammon Hill thou Negro
King of the Southern Sam'l Cate & Murray & my land &
plantation wher on I now live & still to him this his forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Kier four negroes
hereafter mentioned Rachel Allenfield's Kells & 2 Cows & also
one feather bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever

Then I give & bequeath unto my daughter Jean Hill five
shillings to her heirs forever.

Item I give & Bequeath unto Harmon Faro four shillings
to him & his heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto Master Warden five shillings taker ther biers forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Martha Lewis

Item I give Shillings to her other heirs forever
I give & bequeath unto my daughter Bella Webb five
Shillings to her other heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Nelle Hart five Shillings
to her other heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Sweet five Shillings
to her other heirs forever.

Item I bind unto my wife Elizabeth Hill the use & benefit of three
stivers he aye. Much more I cannot do & take & all the
rest of my Estate that is not mucheind to her able Henry
. Hill Coms of age & my will is that then it shalbe equally
divided between my two sons Henry Hill to him & his heirs for
ever & my son Harmon Hill to him & his heirs forever & my
wife Elizabeth Hill during her Natural Life & after her
decease to be equally divided between my two sons to them
and their heirs forever and I do constitute and appoint
my Beloved wife Elizabeth Hill & my son Henry Hill and
Thomas Hart my sole and sole Executors of this my last Will
& Testament revoking disannulling and making void all
other Wills hereafter made by me in respect whereof I have
hereunto set my hand seal this day of 9 January 1772.
