 unto God. Therefore calling unto mind
 the mortality of my body and knowing
 that it is appointed for all men once to die
 do make and ordain this my last will and
 Testament &c. viz. —
 Principally and first of all I give and
 recommend my soul into the hand of God
 that give it and my body I recommend to the
 earth to be buried in a decent Christian
 burial at the discretion of my Executor
 nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection
 I shall receive the same again by the mighty
 Power of God and as touching such —
 worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God
 to bless me with in this life, I give demise
 and dispose of the same in the following
 manner and form, First I give and bequeath
 unto my Son James Horn the sum of ten
 Shillings of proclamation Money. Also I

I have & have been left out of his Deed giving
my land during the time of her natural life
and then to be equally divided between my two
sons Moses Horne & Thomas Horne to them their
heirs & assigns forever all my Estate household
Goods and Invaluable Estate I likewise leave
to my living wife during the time of her
natural life then to be equally divided be-

death or marriage —
then I do give and bequeath to my son William Johnson
a Negro Women name Sarah and her increase
from this date then I do give and bequeath
to my Daughter Ann Clark five pounds.
then I do leave to my wife Sarah Johnson her
choise feather bed and rug and blanket and
two pair sheets and the other furniture
belonging to it and two Pows and Pulley and two
Hefing and two Shaws and three such as she
may choose of with two Sows & Higgs eight
head of two year old Hags my young
